The children in **Primrose Class** have been using their sense to explore all types of food and objects. The children loved all the water activity where they could play with different fruits and rose petals. The children were encouraged to look, touch and smell.

This week the children in **Bluebell Class** have been playing with a variety of wild animals. They have been learning about where they live and what they eat through talk and looking at non-fiction books.





In **Blackberry Class** the children have really enjoyed creating their own kites this week taking advantage of the very windy weather.

This week in **Preschool** the children have been enjoying exploring mini beasts. They have enjoyed learning about tadpoles and drawing the life cycle. The children have also enjoyed making potions with water, plants and filling and emptying.
